Additionally, we have been blessed with the ability to help in times of crisis. We received a total of 75 applications for the next round of grants that will be awarded in March during ALTA SPRINGBOARD, March 15-16 in Tampa, Fla. 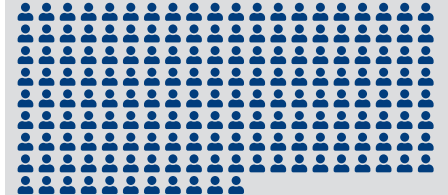

171 INDIVIDUALS DONATED



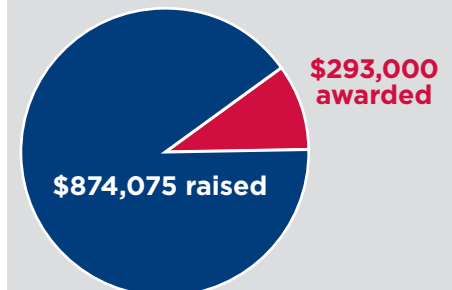

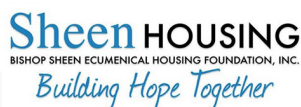

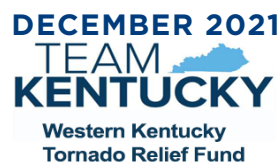

Awarded \$10,000 to assist those impacted by devastating tornadoes



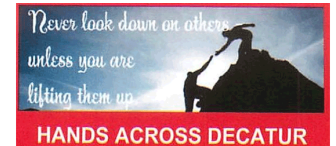
